We are excited for our 10th Anniversary Season and hope to have you join the KML Family!



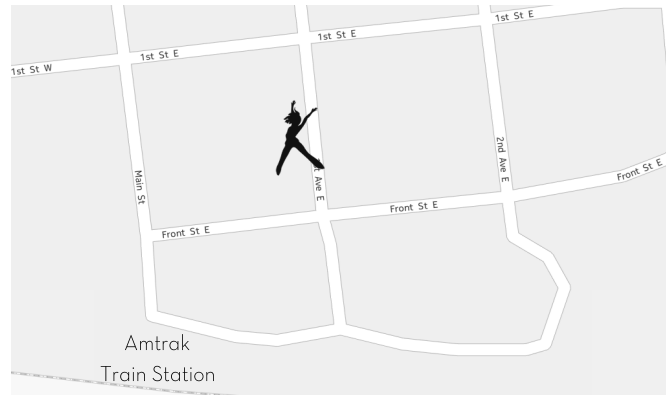

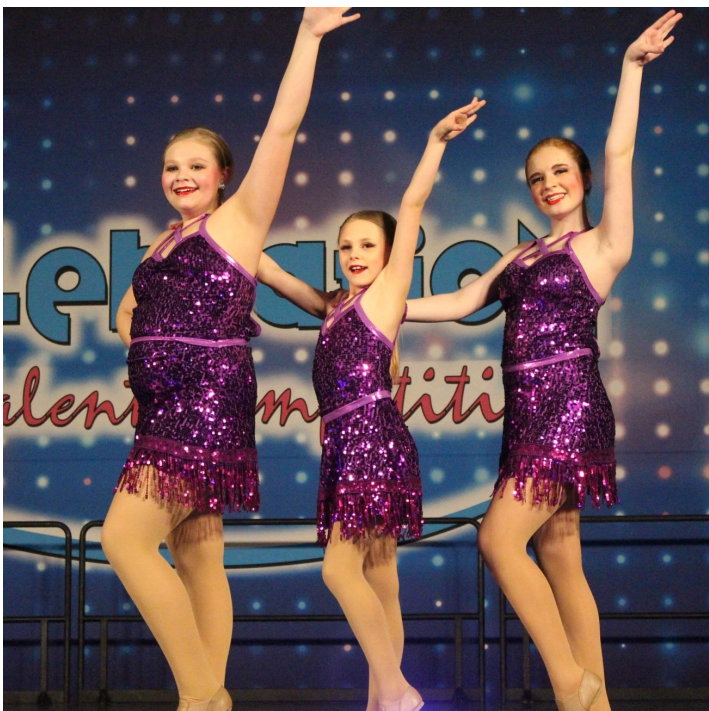

All dancers ages 8-18 must audition to become a part of Kay Michael Lee Studio's Competition Company **Diamond, Ruby, & Emerald Lines**. Auditions are held to place dancers based on ability & age. No private auditions are held.
