Our vision is to become the premier source for dance education, apparel, accessories, and wholesome entertainment for the surrounding region.



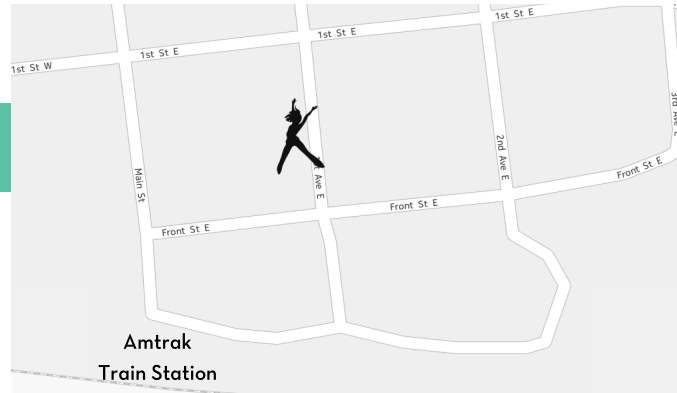
